Serious side effects from giving these types of calcium are pancreatitis, leaky-gut, irritable bowel syndrome, calcium deposits such as kidney/bladder stones, bone spurs, chalky and bloody stools.

Raw bones that are provided domestically have been dead for days, weeks or months before being given to dogs and cats. They are hard, brittle and dehydrated with very little nutritional value.

Raw bones are a source of pleasure to dogs and cats; however, they are used calcium.

The major source of calcium for canines and felines in the wild is the blood that is carrying the calcium to the bones of their prey and the fresh, live, soft, supple, hydrated bones that are full of nutrients. This source of calcium cannot be duplicated domestically by giving dead raw bones.
